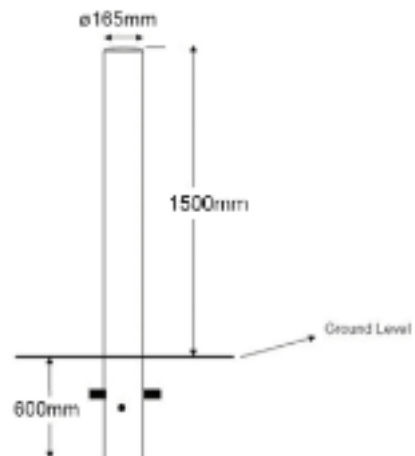

## CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Our Bollards are not only functional but also add a touch of elegance to any environment. To maintain their pristine appearance and extend their lifespan, regular cleaning is essential. Follow these simple steps to properly clean your stainless steel bollards:
